Department of Accounting & Finance of DRT's A.E.Kalsekar Degree College has organized a Group Discussion on the Topic "Life Before and After Covid-19".

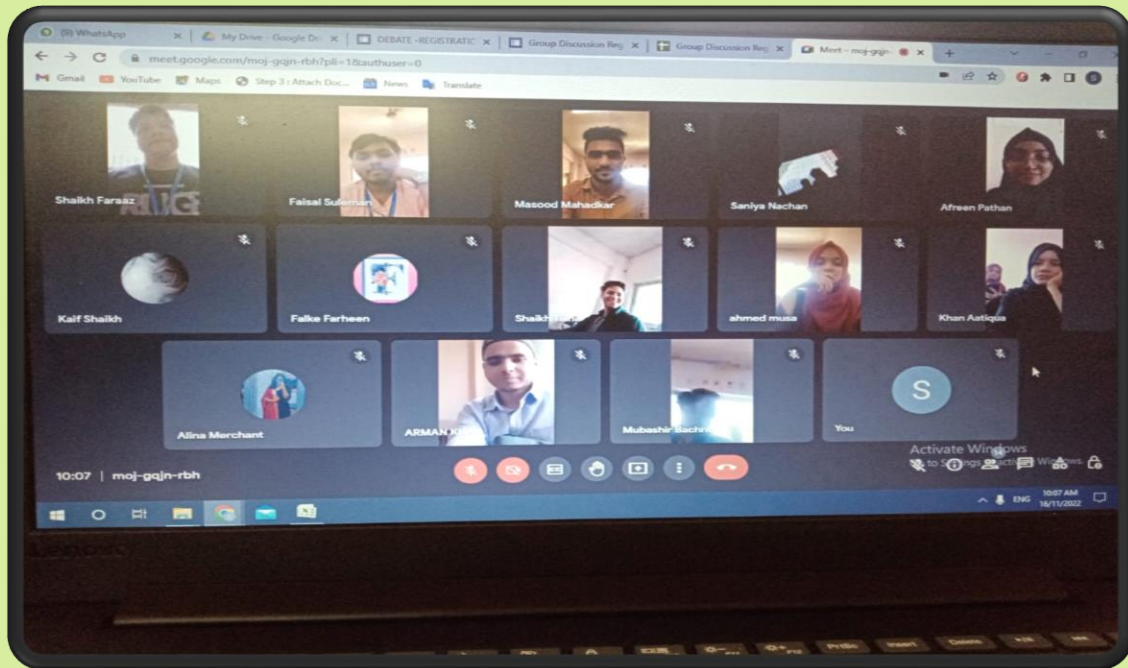
Activity was conducted through online mode via Google Meet. Registration of the activity were accepted via Google form links which was circulated through respective class Whatsap
