Dear

I take this opportunity to introduce you to United Way Mumbai, which is a registered, nonprofit organization working actively in the areas of civic awareness, health, safety and environment in Mumbai city.

According to accident data published by the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways for year 2015;

- Road accidents have killed 1.46 lakh people in India .
- 33% i.e. 48,348 people belonged to the age group of 15 to 24 years
- 25% i.e. 36,803 deaths were caused due to accident involving two wheelers .

As part of our commitment for improving the state of safety in Mumbai city, United Way Mumbai has recently launched a special community impact initiative namely; UNITED FOR ROAD SAFETY (URS), powered by Castrol. The project aims to educate and sensitize youth to safer and responsible two wheeler riders. This is in keeping with the rising death toll due to road accident in India.

Under URS project, we propose to conduct the following activities with the students of your college;

- 3-4 hour classroom session on safe/defensive driving followed by demonstration by Trainer & a on wheel assessment for those carrying valid driving license, own vehicle & proper helmet for batch of maximum 30 participants at a time. (Note : We can conduct multiple training sessions in batches of maximum 30 students per batch.)
 - 1. Upon successful completion of the training, all the students will be awarded a certificate jointly issued by United Way Mumbai and the National Safety Council – Maharashtra Chapter.
 - 2. Formation of " Road Safety Club" of at least 30 enthusiastic student members, who will further undergo another round of advanced training in safe two wheeler riding.
 - 3. The members of the Road Safety Club will be encouraged and empowered to conduct about 5 awareness activities /drives in the college campus or in the neighbouring community to educate peers and for community members on Near Bharat Gear Factory, road safety.

Note: United Way Mumbai will support the club members for successful execution of these activities.
