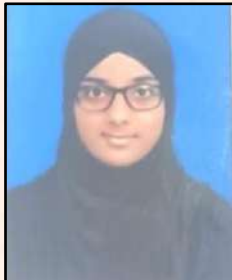

ACTIVITIES

Due to COVID-19 restrictions events were conducted throughout the year on a virtual platform. Following is the list of events and activities conducted by the research committee during the academic year 2020-2021:

➤ **Webinar**

Research Committee in collaboration with IQAC organized one day Webinar on “**Writing Research Proposal for Minor and Major Research Project**” by Dr. Rosewin Joy, Assistant Professor (Business Analytics and Economics) Founder Coordinator SDG center, Presidency University, Bangalore, India on Saturday 13th February 2021 at Noon.

The Webinar was highly successful with more than 50 participants from various colleges. This event was highly enriching and helped participants to learn the art of writing an effective research proposal. The Resource person was addressed with a modern approach to the entire research fraternity and answered all the questions in the best possible way.

➤ **15th Avishkar Meeting, Thane Zone**

Avishkar is one such platform that has been made available by the University of Mumbai to its students and faculty to demonstrate their research potential. The major aim of the Avishkar Research convention is to inculcate research culture among the students, to encourage creative thinking and to provide an opportunity for the expression of academic talent. This workshop was different from the normal years due to Covid-19 distress as the entire process of Avishkar was on online mode.

The Avishkar meeting of Thane Zone was held on 20.03.2021 on the zoom platform. The meeting was addressed by Dr. Bhusan Langi and Dr. Vaishali Nirmalkar. Mentors and students of our college along with many reputed colleges in the Thane zone had actively participated in the meeting.

➤ **15th Avishkar Research Workshop, University of Mumbai**

The University of Mumbai organises workshops for giving information regarding proposal preparations and the registration process. The Meeting was held on the Zoom platform as well as live-streamed on YouTube on 24th March 2021. Resource persons were extremely

knowledgeable and helpful. Session-1 was addressed by Dr. Minakshi Gurav on Avishkar Rules and Regulations, Session-2 by Dr. Sunita Shailajan on Designing a Research Proposal, and Session-3 by Dr. Shashikumar Menon on Preparing Research Presentation. It was a highly enriching session, students and mentors learned a lot about research and proposal-related preparation. Students and Mentors were awarded participation certificates by the University of Mumbai for being a part of the workshop. Selection of this course under the department was an initiative to promote and inculcate research-based approach among students. These students are benefited by proper understanding of utilization of tools for research thus inculcating a formal and systematic research approach among students.

Faculty had successfully completed TOT program under Food Industry capacity skill initiative, a sector skill council under national skill Development Corporation. Faculty was guided by certified trainer for 3 job roles under FICSI under Skill India initiative.

Department of botany in collaboration with N.S.S Unit had organized webinar on **challenges in water management** by Dr. Ajit Gokhale (Natural Solutions) on 24th March 2021. The event was organized in the week of world water Day. In the webinar, resource person had focused on improper land and water management. Session was well complimented with power point presentations, Videos and some pictures which made the session impactful for the participants.

In both semesters, department had conducted remedial lectures and online tests for students to help them upgrade their academic performances. Department also had conducted mentoring sessions for the learners to provide them necessary support to overcome their personal, social and academic barriers and focused on their overall development. Students were provided with PDFs, PPTs and video links (virtual practical) through online modes for facilitating and comforting online learning for students.

Department reflected its effort to change its approach of activities by blending and adopting technological approach as a current necessity to keep student actively engaged and help them adapt and sustain this momentous change.

DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY

The Department of Chemistry serves as platform to develop the skills of the students. The aim of Chemistry Department is to create knowledge among students about current affairs of chemistry, building interest in innovative research and to make them career oriented. The department has successfully completed first term by online mode.

- **Webinar on "Covid-19 on Chemistry Perspective”**: The Department of Chemistry had organised one day webinar on 28th July 2020 on the topic "Covid-19 on Chemistry Perspective", by Dr. Sands Jaybhaye Assistant Professor from B.K. Birla College Kalyan. The webinar was very informative. The aim of conducting Webinar

was to aware participants about changes occurred by pandemic from scientific point of view.

- Two Days Online Guest Lecture Series On " Analytical Chemistry": On 7th and 15th December 2020, the department of chemistry had successfully organized two days guest lecture series on Analytical Chemistry by Mr. Vinayak P. Gawde at Zoom app. and by Ms. Yogita Sonawane on Google Meet respectively. The aim of conducting the same was to improve the knowledge particular topic and to provide deep understanding of science. Students from Sy and Ty BSc had attended both the lectures.
- One Day Online Guest Lecture Series On " Instruments of Analytical Chemistry": On 22nd March 2021, the Department of Chemistry had successfully completed one day online guest lecture on the topic of analytical chemistry 'Instrumentation' by Mr. Vinayak P. Gawde on zoom app. The aim of conducting the lecture was to improve the basic knowledge of students to that particular subject. Students from TY and SY attended the same.
- "CHEM TALK": On 2nd April 2021, department of chemistry in collaboration with cultural committee organized CHEM TALK event where students got chance to express their views on certain given topic. The main criteria for conducting the event were to make students able to talk on pure chemistry topic.

DEPARTMENT OF ZOOLOGY

At the beginning of the year 2020-2021, Department of Zoology had planned several events and activities which could potentially enhance the learning capacities of the students, on field experiences, ability to observe and improve overall development.

24th August department started our first TYBSC lecture along with online lecture in the background of COVID 19 pandemic. department had shared online resources and all subject wise PDF books to students. As soon as the TYBSC and other classes started, college had provided them book bank facility.

On 28th August, one of the TYBSC students (Amrin Shaikh) had given Power point presentation on '**BIRD FEATHERS**' to TYBSC chemistry plus zoology (combined class) students. Total 54 students had attended this event and the faculty of zoology department helped this student to carry out research on the bird feathers in detail.

On August 29th few students from our class have participated in webinar on whale shark conservation. This not only gave exhaustive information on marine animals but also helped students to understand the post-graduation resources after the completion of their degree.

Faculty member of Zoology had practiced of sharing specimen photos from the field or from the internet. So, the subject interest of the students had inclined and it also helped them to learn about various animals in their syllabus. It also helped them to understand the biodiversity around their house or college campus.

On 31st of August, the preadmission form and earn and learn scheme for the student has been started. So, the low family income students would be easy to study while learning within the college library and other administrative work of our college. Every year our college always trying to help the students in every possible way.

On September 2nd students had a chance to actively participate in the virtual nature excursion. This was leaded by senior zoology professor Dr. Parvish Pandya. Here the students have seen floral and faunal diversity on virtual basis via some photographs and videos which were recorded earlier in the field. It was mesmerizing event which was enjoyed by students and faculties too.

On 3rd September, workshop on stress management and pandemic was arranged. It was followed by counselling session for our students. This also helped them to understand the COVID 19 infection as well as how to take precautions/handle of pre COVID and post COVID periods.

On 4th September, many of students from different class had attended session on butterflies of India by expert, Mr. ISAAC KEHIMKAR. There beautiful slides kept all students hooked up towards the computer screen. Many species shown over here was very rare to see or locate in remote parts of our country.

On 5th of September month, all the student and teachers had celebrated the teacher's day with the session on **'BIODIVERSITY AROUND US'**.

On 14th of September, students have joined for coastal wetlands lecture which was kept under the national virtual seminar. This event has shown students, how our mangroves are helping us in protecting environment and why one should save oceans and creeks without plastic.

On 25th September, PARYAVARAN DAKSHATA MANDAL, thane has shown our student a live session on fish farming which was led by Dr. Prasad Karnik. Here the brackish

water culture and freshwater aquaculture was taught and explained by showing different nursery ponds and adults' ponds with full of fishes.

On October 11th, students had taken a pledge for a **JANA ANDOLAN FOR COVID 19 APPROPRIATE BEHAVIOUR PLEDGE**, for good cause and society benefits. It was arranged with good communication with NSS team of our college.

On 28th October, follow up meeting for fees payment and other issues of students has been solved by doing counselling for the students. Further our college has created a helpline email where all students can email their respective queries. aekalsekarstudentshelpline@gmail.com

On November 5th, all the students and faculties had successfully participated in the **bird week festival** which was celebrated as state level initiative. On 2nd December, the surprise tests were held for students benefit and revision of the completed portion. This also helps to understand the overall progress of our different classes.

On 27th of January, many students of our three classes had participated in Zorilla 2020-21 at Somaiya College campus, Ghatkopar. These are multi-tasking events, helping to develop with different sets of skills and teamwork among our students.

In the Semester V EXAMINATIONS many students secured A+ GRADE and others passed with flying colours. The overall class passing percentage was 95%.

In February month from 23rd to 24th all the students had coordinated and actively participated in cultural events arranged within our college campus. Various competitions like calligraphy; poetry was enjoyed by our students.

On 23rd March, the students were very lucky to hear some detailed lecture on an excellent session on **CHALLENGES ON WATER MANAGEMENT** by expert Dr. Ajit Gokhale sir. One of the senior faculty members of our zoology department has been assigned as a moderator in one of the local autonomous colleges in Andheri. 

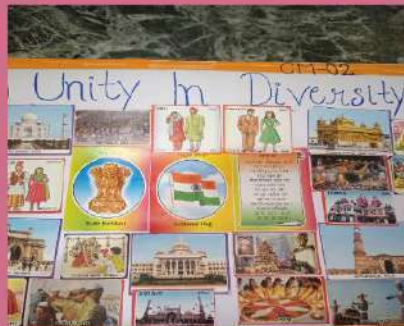
