Many individuals from college staff, students as well as nearby vicinity donated blood around 22 Units of blood were collected. A walkathon was organised by NSS unit with collaboration of the sports department of college on 4th September 2021 in which a small walk was conducted in a nearby area to create awareness on fitness.

NSS day was celebrated on 24th September 2021 on this occasion an online seminar was organised by the NSS unit to give information about NSS. 2nd October 2021 was celebrated as Gandhi Jayanti on the occasion of birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi (the father of nation) an online session was organised on nonviolence and knowledge about gandhian principles. Total 68 volunteers among which 55 were female and 3 were male took part in this event.

3. Guest lecture on Polycystic Ovarian Syndrome-








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
